## Your child's next topic will be:

History– 'Who Raids Wins'

Science – 'Sound' and 'Animals including Humans'

English – Story settings, play scripts, persuasive writing

Maths – All areas of maths will be covered this term. Number work, shape and calculations as well as a focus on times tables.



## During this term, your child will learn about:

### History

Our topic will focus on the Vikings and their struggle with the Anglo Saxons for the Kingdom of England. We will learn about how the Vikings lived, how and when they invaded and where they settled.



### Science

We will be learning about sound, how it is made and how it can be changed. Our second topic looks at humans and in particular the digestive system and teeth.



## The children will concentrate on:

### English

We will look at persuasive writing and linking this to our History work, persuading people to join our Anglo Saxon and Viking villages.

We will be reading a range of stories set in different places, countries and times. In particular, we will read Michael Morpurgo's Butterfly Lion. We will be writing our own stories.

### Maths

As well as a focus on times tables, we will be focusing mainly on number work and calculations. In particular, we will be trying to apply our Maths skills to real life problems involving, money, time and measures. We will also continue to learn about shape and different graphs and charts.
