# At Oughton, we are focusing on raising attainment in reading, writing and maths.

**Maths:** In Maths, the children will be continuing to look at many areas to include counting, place value (TO), number order, using counting beads, looking for patterns in number, alongside +, -, x and  $\div$ . The children learn Maths in a very practical way so that children see Maths and its relevance in the wider world.

English: In English, we will starting with a traditional tales unit, looking at lots of familiar stories and having a go at writing their own. We will then move onto a poetry unit where the children will read different free verse poems and write their own poems. We will also be learning about reports and writing individual reports. This will be in conjunction with daily Phonics and Guided Reading. The children will also continue to work towards joining their letters, through our handwriting scheme.

#### Ways to help your children:

**English:** Read with your child every night. Encourage them to discuss the story and question them about the characters, plot, setting and even the meaning of tricky words. Do not forget to fill out the yellow contact book so we know that your child has read at home.

<u>Maths:</u> Counting is extremely important, please encourage your child to count. This could be counting ingredients for dinner, pennies in a money box and how many cars you see on the way to school. This can also be linked to addition and subtraction.
