Your Child's next topic will be

History – Romans. Geography - How can we live more sustainably?
Science – 'Light' and 'Plants'
English – Adventure Stories, Persuasive Writing and Poetry
Maths – All areas of Maths will be covered this term. Multiplication, Division and Time in particular.



During this term, your child will learn about:

Topic

Our topic will be History and Geography based. We shall be investigating the Romans, who they were and where they came from. In Geography, we shall be investigating how we can live more sustainably.

Science

We will be learning about plants and how they grow. We will be learning about the formation of light and how shadows are formed.

Music

We shall be learning to sing and perform 'The Dragon Song', exploring pitch, volume and rhythm.

Art

We shall be exploring and creating our own mosaics.

DT.

We shall be researching and creating savoury party snacks.

During this term, we will also cover Relationships and Changes in PSHCE.

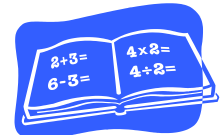
The children will concentrate on:

English

We will be writing effective sentences to write our own adventure story. Additionally, we will write persuasive texts, then reading and writing our own poetry. We shall be focusing particularly on sentence structure and vocabulary choices. Choosing appropriate and specific vocabulary to 'deepen the moment' of our writing will be our focus.

Maths

We will be focusing mainly on number work particularly multiplication and division including problem solving. The long division method will be covered as well as on going work on times tables. The class will also be working on time and shape and space.
