History - 'Walk like an Egyptian'

During this term, your child will learn about:

Topic

Our topics will be History and Geography based. We shall be investigating Ancient Egypt, learning about life in Ancient Egypt, Egyptian religion and how the Greeks influenced the modern world. In Geography, we shall be investigating why jungles are wet and desserts are dry and exploring climates.

<u>Science</u>

We will be learning about digestion as well learning about electricity and creating a circuit.

Music

We will be learning 'Blackbird' by The Beatles and we will be composing music using instruments.

Art

We will be creating Egyptian clay statues.

We will be creating a reading light.

The children will concentrate on:

English

We will be reading Anne Fine's book 'Bill's New Frock' and looking at the themes of stereotyping and bullying. We will look at the themes of other stories and writing our own. We will continue learning about discussion writing, creating balanced arguments. Finally, we will look at explanation writing linked to our Science topics.

Maths

We will continue to focus on number work and calculations. We will recap different shapes and their properties including angles. We will continue to learn about fractions and decimals. Throughout the term we will be applying our Maths skills to solve different types of problems.

We will be working on the target of your child learning their times tables up to 12x12 and be able to answer within 6 seconds. Please help your child at home to reach this target.

Ways to help your children are:

Hear your child read every day and ask them questions about their book.

Practise times tables as often as possible. The children can use the Times Tables Rock Stars website or App to help them to do this.

Remember swimming kit every Wednesday (until half term)
