Your Child's next topic will be

Topic – Tudors and Mountains Science - Living Things and their Habitats English - Mystery and Suspense Stories and Macbeth Maths – All areas of Maths will be covered this term. Number fluency will be a particular focus.



During this term, your child will learn about:

Topic

Our topic will focus on the Tudors. The children will learn about Tudor life, the key events of the period and how to use historical sources. In Geography, we will be learning about mountains; how they are formed and how people live around them.

We will be focusing on our team game skills in PE and will be learning about Tag-Rugby and cricket. In Music, we will be continuing to learn the song 'Fresh Prince of Bel Air' and in Art, we will be exploring Tudor portrait, focusing on how to draw a face. In D&T, we will be designing, creating and evaluating our own toy using gears.

Science

We will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats. In particular, we will be focusing on our experimentation. This will include writing predictions, clear methods and considered conclusions.

During this term, we will also cover Relationships and Changes in PSHE.

The children will concentrate on:

English

We are studying texts written by William Shakespeare, we will be planning and writing a mystery story and re-writing Macbeth. The children will be using their imaginations to think of characters and settings. In particular, the children will be building up an understanding of the vocabulary and grammatical features that build suspense in a story.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be working on number fluency this term and equipping the children with the basic skills that they will need for Year 6. In addition, we will be building a deeper understanding of the written methods including explaining how they work.

Ways to help your children are:

To encourage your child to read every day and sign home contact book. Talk about the book in particular language and the characters.

To help complete home learning tasks on Teams every week.

To spend time on Mathletics and Times Table Rockstars, around 30 minutes each week.
