Topic

In History, we will be continuing to explore Ancient Greeks and how sources support our understanding of a period in time. In Geography, we are exploring fair trade. During DT this term, we will be sampling different soups before creating our own soup. This term, our Art will focus on exploring a mixed-media project. French will begin with understanding vocabulary used in every day conversation and how to find your way around a French town.



The children will concentrate on:

English

Throughout the term, we will be studying a range of texts and use these to develop further the children's suspense fiction writing. We will look at producing balanced arguments on a range of topics and use debating skills to present these. Towards the end of the term, the children will have many drama opportunities through working with play scripts.

Maths

The children will start the term by revising learning from this year and making sure all feel confident as we head towards SATs. We will finish the year by making links towards the secondary learning, looking a problem solving tasks and how to use a calculator.
