



Hitchin Food Provision Team

Information for Families

The team who normally come together to provide Christmas Hampers have formed to become the Hitchin Food Provision Team. Families may have found themselves in unexpected financial difficulties due to the measures being taken to keep us safe and we wanted to provide some support to help.

Criteria

If you have been furloughed, become unemployed, self-employed and not able to work or have significantly reduced hours, delays to benefits we would like to support you with a supermarket e-voucher to help you provide for your family. We are helping families who are not able to access other avenues of support; Universal Credits, Free School Meals*, Food Parcels via Herts Help.

**If you are entitled to Free Schools Meals we hope you are receiving the voucher or lunches via your child's/children's schools. If you need further help we can refer you to Feed Up Warm Up who are able to provide a food parcel and essential household items (please note this is subject to availability). If your child attends a Hitchin School and lives outside of Hitchin we will refer you to the local Foodbank.*

How to get support:

Please contact your child's school who will be able to give you a form to complete, we will then contact you by phone to confirm details and arrange an e-voucher as appropriate. You can also contact the North Herts Healthy Hub (01462 474 111) who will be able to help.
