Through grants, funding and donations we can provide some financial help to you and your family. We have an emergency fund to help families and individuals buy food with a supermarket e-voucher.

It is simple to apply:

Send an email to foodprovision-hitchin@wilshere.herts.sch.uk and request a self-referral form. You can download the form from www.hitchinpartnership.org.uk. The form asks for a few essential details; we can call you back if you need any assistance.

We do have some criteria:

- Living in Hitchin or surrounding Hitchin village.
- Hitchin Food Provision are providing support to families who are unable to access Universal Credits/Benefits and Free School Meals or are waiting for Universal Credits.
- If you have been furloughed, become unemployed, self-employed and not able to work or have significantly reduced hours.

What happens next?

You will receive a reply to your email within 48 hours. Once approved you will receive a supermarket e-voucher.
