Week beginning: 23rd March

Please find below a list of activities to complete during the week. It is not essential that all are done and do not feel limited by this if you have your own ideas too. At school, we do Maths and English every day and would like you to do so on weekdays. The tasks will be different each week. Science, PE and RE are done every week at school so these activities will change weekly. All other subjects are done on rotation so you have two weeks for these ones before new ones will be set after Easter.

English – recount writing

Write a sentence everyday about what you can see or what you have done that day. You could draw a small picture to go with your sentence too. Remember to check your work through for punctuation and to check it makes sense.

Ongoing: daily reading is a key priority. You also need to practise your phonics using the sounds you were given or you could have a go on games on Phonicsplay or Teach Your Monster To Read (see list of websites and apps)

Maths - topic: money

Borrow some coins. Can you sort them in different ways? How much are they worth? Can you make different amounts? Play shopping and practise paying for different items.

Ongoing: Keep counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you count backwards as well?

Science - topic: signs of spring

Look out of your window. What signs of spring can you see? What other signs are there? Think about the weather, plants and animals. Make a list of all the signs, drawing a picture and labelling each one.

History - topic: the Great Fire Of London

What can you find out about this? Draw a timeline of what happened.

Geography – topic: mapping skills

Think about where you live. Draw a map of where your home is, including how you get to school. You might even include key features such as the park, the shops and even where some of your friends live.

RE- topic: the Easter story

We have learnt about the Easter story. Draw pictures of the important days such as Good Friday and Easter Sunday and write a sentence about each one.

PE - topics: ball skills

This week practise the skills we have been learning. Try to throw and catch a ball. Can you do it one handed? Is it trickier if you try with a different ball? How many catches and throws can you do? Try keeping active every day using ideas from BBC supermovers or skipping.

Art - topic: the Great Fire of London

Use what you know about different colours to create a fire picture. You can use colours, paints or different paper to make a collage. If you would prefer you could do a detailed drawing.

DT - topic: playgrounds

Think about what you like playing on at the playground. Draw a picture and label how it works.

Music - topic: rhythms

Listen to any music. Can you find the beat? What ways can you think of to keep the beat? What sort of music is it? Explain whether you like it or not and why.

Computing – topic: esafety

This week we would like you to tell us what you know about how to stay safe online. Include top tips and strategies. You could write about it, make a poster or your own idea.
