As we've now got the online music school up and running, we thought we could extend it to include recorder club.

Using slightly different log in details your child can access an online recorder book called Blown Away to continue learning to play the recorder.

The log in details are as follows:

- Username- first and last name ( no spaces)
- Password- recorderclub ( no spaces)

All lower case, as the other log in.

Once logged in the children can explore the different sections and revisit/learn each note.

You can slow the speed of the track under 'tempo' at the bottom of the screen whilst you are learning the piece of music and when you are more confident, then play in actual time. The fingerings for notes are also shown whilst the song is playing to help you learn new notes (you will also find note fingerings in your recorder book). If you are unsure about note values, the track on Charanga will help you with this so please listen whilst you play along.

As the class was a mixture of abilities Ms Evans has suggested:

Front group - please start from Introducing A to Introducing E. You can then move onto the songs with 'E' in your recorder books when you feel ready.

Middle group - please start from Introducing G to Introducing D. You can then move onto the songs with 'D' in your recorder books when you feel ready.

Back group - please start from introducing 'D' to introducing 'high C & D'. You can then move onto the remainder of the songs in your recorder books when you feel ready.

Let me know how you get on and happy playing.
