Alder have won for 2 weeks running with Beech on their heels! Each week, both classes have attendance of over 96% which is our aim for all classes. Attendance Ted has been staying with these two classes over the last 3 weeks and they have had extra playtime too!

Parental Communication

Just to remind you, staff are extremely busy teaching children during the school day and are unable to call or email during the day. We have had many Parents who have emailed in the evening out of school working hours and expect a response the following day. This is not often possible. Messages are passed onto Teachers during working hours, however, our priority is teaching and first thing in the morning, Teachers are organising their lessons. Staff will contact Parents, and of course deal with issues, but please be patient.

If you have a piece of information which is important, involving Safeguarding, please come to the front office and staff there will then pass your message to someone who will be in touch. We are not often able to meet with Parents immediately as most staff are continually working with children and in classes.
