Attendance

Our whole school target is 96%. We are currently at 95.5 %. Some classes have received a reward this term, having completed their Perfect Attendance sheet. It is vital that every child attends school regularly. There is a strong link with good attendance to good progress and achievement. If a child's attendance drops below 90%, this is a concern for us and their attendance will be monitored closely. Medical evidence must be given at this point - all absences will be unauthorised without medical evidence and penalty fines will be given. Mrs Woollon meets with children and their Parents to discuss attendance. Holidays will be unauthorised, unless there are special circumstances.

Snow at Oughton!

Thank you to Mrs Banton for her hard work in ensuring the school was safe last Friday. It is always exciting when it snows!

Please ensure that you are using ParentMail. If ever we take the decision to close the school, this will be a last resort and **Parents will be the first to know**. We will send a text out via Parentmail or an email. Always assume we are open unless you hear otherwise from us - not via a friend.

Please do not ring the school to ask if we are open as this ends up prolonging messages to parents as we try to communicate and answer phones.

When it snows, we normally shut some entrance and exit points to limit access. We ensure these are clear and often use the front entrance for KS 2 and the walkway to KS 1. Please ensure you use the path when walking on the school site.

Please send your child in suitable footwear such as wellington boots / walking boots and with their normal school shoes.



Times Table Awards

This term we have launched a new Times Table challenge to KS 2 children. All children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 have the opportunity to earn badges linked to table facts.

We have introduced Red, Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum badges. Children earn badges through completion of a times table grid leading to the Gold Award - all tables up to 12x12 out of order, and Platinum, with associated division facts.

Please help your child learn their multiplication facts, this is vital for so many areas of maths and will help them in the future. Remember, all children have access to Times Table Rock Stars website and app. Passwords are in your child's Reading Contact books.

ICT and Gaming

Please monitor your child's use of ICT (computers, ipads, Xbox, phones etc) as we have been increasingly aware of many children using devices for many hours at a time. This type of activity has a negative impact on their ability to learn and focus, sometimes leading to friendship issues.

Please ensure that games used are **appropriate for their age**. We hear a lot regarding **Fortnite** which has a PEGI rating of 12. PEGI has said that this is due to the: 'frequent scenes of mild violence. It is not suitable for persons under **12 years** of age.' However, this game is the main topic of conversation of many of our primary children.

Please check the games children are playing and what they are doing on the internet, including videos on YouTube.

Governor Update
