WRITING (Check History learning First)

Your challenge this week is to write a story based around World War 2 and VE day (Victory in Europe day). My model focuses on a fighter pilot getting ready to fly however your story can focus on any part of the war! This week, we are only writing the start of the story so only write a maximum of 2 or 3 paragraphs. In this part of the story, focus on building suspense and introducing the characters. In my story, the main event will be the battle in the sky. **I will not** be writing about this during this week. Try and include our Year 5 grammar like parenthesis and relative clauses too.

Please see the attached support sheet for more ideas facts about WW2 and a teacher model. You can carry on from where my model finishes or simply rewrite the paragraph I have used for my model!

MATHS

This week in Maths we will be practising the main written methods for multiplication and division. I have included a worksheet for you to do and examples of each method. However, remember you can also access Oughton's calculation policy via our website, which will help you to follow the written methods.

Maths Practical:

Your job this week is to write a short paragraph about an activity that includes Maths. Last week I suggested cooking so this week try and write about time.

There are many things you could write about but here are some ideas:

- The duration of an activity in hours
- The duration of an activity in minutes and hours
- The difference in duration between two different activities

Do not panic about how to record this information, you could use bullet points to record each mathematical step or write it as a full paragraph. However, if you have another way this will be great too!

Remember to use Mathletics too! You should have received the login via parentmail.

<p><u>Reading:</u> In reading this week I have included a reading task. Read the text and try and answer the questions. This is a difficult task and will be best done with an adult to help you. If you can't access the sheet, try and write a review of the book you are reading. Tell me what you are enjoying and if you would recommend it to a friend.</p>	<p><u>DAILY READING</u> There is still an expectation that children will read at least three times a week and fill in their journals. This week I would like you to pick some foods you like and dislike and then write a short sentence about them telling me which you like and which you do not. J'aime is French for I like. J'adore is French for I love. Je n'aime pas is French for I do not like. Don't forget the little le / la words for 'the' You could use Google translate but don't worry about this activity if you do not have internet access.</p>
<p><u>SCIENCE</u> Last week in science you were able to research a topic you enjoyed. According to your feedback, this was very popular so this week you have the opportunity to do so again with an additional challenge. You could research Earth and space, animals of the oceans, materials or any other scientific topic! This is your chance to dig more deeply into the subject you enjoy. You could write about the information you find, create a poster or even make a video on an I Pad. However, your additional challenge is to plan an experiment around your chosen topic. However, do not worry if this is too difficult.</p>	<p><u>SPAG.COM</u> We will upload SPAG work for you to complete online.</p>	<p><u>History</u> In the coming week, I would like you to continue your research into WW2 because it is the focus of our writing. I am writing a story about aircraft in WW2 so I would research facts about WW2 aircraft. I would suggest that you write 5-10 bullet points about your research so you can use the facts in your writing.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> This week in PE I would like you to create a circuit training routine. Remember, circuit training involves around 5 exercises for a minute each, with a 30 second rest period in between. Activities you could include: press-ups, sit-ups, running on the spot, star jumps and even the plank! Try and do your routine 4 times a week!</p>
<p><u>Art</u> This week, your art challenge is to create a piece inspired by the artist Kandinsky. He often uses circles and vibrant colours in his art.
